Sec. 502 allows the Transforming Children's Behavioral Health Policy and Planning Committee to contract with the Yale Child Study Center to determine if additional federal funding is available and to conduct a trial of the center to see if it may qualify as an evidence-based treatment program resulting in a potential cost to the Office of Legislative Management (OLM). If the committee decides to contract with Yale for these services, there is a potential cost to OLM of approximately \$200,000 to \$500,000 in FY 26. The exact cost is dependent on the services requested and the terms of the contract between Yale and the committee.

The amendment makes other technical, clarifying, and conforming changes that do not result in a fiscal impact.
