### ***OFA Fiscal Note***

### ***No Fiscal Impact***

The amendment: (1) extends the bill's time frame that health insurers have to notify a health care provider of an appeal decision by five days; (2) increases the number of members of the working group established by the bill; and (3) eliminates Sections 4 and 5 of the underlying bill, which established new practices constituting unfair insurance practices with respect to health. These changes result in no fiscal impact as they do not change the Insurance Department's workload.
