## **OFA Fiscal Note**

## **Potential Cost**

The amendment results in a potential cost of up to \$100,000 to the Department of Economic and Community Development by requiring the agency to report on the impact of Sections 1-3 of the underlying bill on the firearms industry, including on state revenues and job and industry retention.

In order to meet the required deadline of February 1, 2026, DECD may require consulting services. The cost may be partially mitigated to the extent that the staff in DECD or other relevant state agencies are able to assist with the study.
