OFA Fiscal Note

Cost

The amendment establishes a school resource officer grant program administered by the State Department of Education (SDE). This results in a cost to SDE beginning in FY 27 based on the funding level of the grant, which is not prescribed by the amendment, and a corresponding revenue gain to recipient towns. The grant to a town is limited to the annual cost for the employment of one new school resource officer, which is expected to be between \$75,000 and \$150,000, depending on the officer's salary and town fringe benefit costs.
