The amendment permits municipalities to opt out of the provisions of the underlying bill which allow temporary shelter units if they (1) hold a public hearing, (2) vote in the permitted time frame, (3) state the reason for the decision, and (4) publish a notice in a newspaper. This results in a potential cost to municipalities associated with holding a public hearing and publishing a notice in a newspaper.

The amendment requires municipalities complete this process by January 1, 2027. This limits any potential cost to FY 26 and FY 27 only.

Any municipality that opts out will have no fiscal impact associated with the underlying bill which is dependent on how the temporary shelters are used.
