OFA Fiscal Note

Eliminates Fiscal Impact in Bill

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

The amendment, which requires the Department of Public Health (DPH) to annually report to the legislature the number of calls made to the Connecticut Poison Control Center concerning psilocybin affecting children, adolescents and adults, results in no fiscal impact. DPH has the necessary resources and expertise to fulfill this requirement.
