The amendment results in savings to Medicaid due to prohibiting surgery and treatment related to gender reassignment for minors. Medicaid currently covers gender affirming services for individuals under the age of 18 on a case-by-case basis. The number of individuals and associated costs are unknown at this time.

The amendment results in savings to the Office of the State Comptroller to the extent it prohibits state expenditures related to gender affirming care for members under the age of 18 enrolled in the state employee health plan.
