Explanation

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact. The amendment requires the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) to continue meeting, on developing released-based cleanup regulations, after the regulations have been adopted. The amendment makes various procedural and clarifying changes. This is not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact to DEEP as they have the staff and expertise necessary to staff the working group.
