The amendment strikes the language in the underlying bill and the associated fiscal impact.

The amendment results in the same fiscal impact as the underlying bill associated with changing the maximum age for individuals on the Katie Beckett waiver from 21 to 18 years of age.

The amendment also requires the Department of Social Services (DSS) to make certain information available on the agency web site and annually administer a survey to individuals on the waiver wait list. This is not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact to DSS as the agency has the expertise necessary to meet these provisions.
