Explanation

The amendment, which requires the State Fire Marshal to create a pilot program for two municipalities to provide reimbursement to firefighters for cancer screening, results in a cost of \$15,000 in FY 26 and FY 27. The costs are dependent upon the number of firefighters eligible and partaking in the cancer screenings program and undergo screenings that are not already covered by their health insurance.
