The amendment strikes the language in section 22 of the underlying bill as amended and associated fiscal impact.

Section 22 allows the Department of Social Services (DSS) to contract with FDA-approved generic GLP-1 manufacturers, potentially through an interstate consortium. The state may experience savings to the extent DSS incurs lower related expenditures.
