No Fiscal Impact

The amendment adds a provision to the underlying bill that mandates that, beginning in FY 27, each abortion performed in the state must be reported to the Commissioner of Public Health by a patient's health care provider. This results in no fiscal impact to the state or municipalities. The amendment states that the report shall not include the name of the patient and must specify certain information.
