The amendment eliminates section 6 of the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

The amendment results in a potential cost to municipalities beginning in FY 26 to the extent they are subject to an action brought in superior court. Any cost will be dependent on (1) who prevails in an action, and (2) on court costs and attorney's fees associated with the action. This provision only applies to municipalities with a population of 70,000 or more.¹
