The amendment removes the provisions that allow state and municipal employees to collectively bargain “hours and other conditions of employment” and replaces it with “health insurance and retirement benefits.” This results in an uncertain fiscal impact to the state and municipalities to the extent it changes the outcome of collective bargaining negotiations, agreements, and arbitration awards.
