The amendment results in a minimal savings to local and regional school districts annually beginning in FY 26. It limits the number of school restrooms in which districts must provide menstrual products that are free to students. This results in a savings that will vary based on the amount of menstrual products districts otherwise would have purchased for these restrooms.
