The amendment requires local and regional boards of education to designate an existing employee to be an instructional support partner, which does not change the fiscal impact of the underlying bill. The instructional support partner must use 50% of their time in FY 27, 75% in FY 28, and 100% in FY 29 performing specific responsibilities. As in the underlying bill, this results in a cost to BOEs starting as early as FY 27, with full implementation in FY 29, to hire one staff member to perform functions that the existing employee would have otherwise done, for all schools that currently lack such a person.
