The amendment strikes sections 1-15 of the underlying bill and the associated fiscal impact related to the Early Childhood Education Endowment (ECEE).

The amendment appropriates \$40 million in FY 26 and FY 27 from the General Fund to the Office of Early Childhood (OEC) for early childhood programs.
