The amendment expands a provision that allows municipalities with a population of 10,000 or less to include municipalities with a population of 16,000 or less. This provision allows municipalities to petition for a town referendum on the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection's or the Connecticut Siting Council's decisions regarding certain permits. This results in a potential cost to municipalities to the extent a referendum is held.
