The amendment strikes sections 5 and 6 of the underlying bill and eliminates the cost associated with licensing municipal day camps.

The amendment results in a cost to the Office of Policy and Management (OPM) beginning in FY 26 and a corresponding revenue gain to municipalities.

The amendment requires OPM to establish and administer a grant program to offset various costs to municipalities related to municipal camp programs. The amendment specifies that each grant may be up to \$5,000 per municipality. This results in an annual cost of up to \$845,000 to OPM annually beginning in FY 26 and corresponding revenue gain to municipalities.¹
