The amendment strikes sections 6 and 7 of the underlying bill and eliminates the cost associated with licensing municipal day camps.

The amendment results in a potential cost beginning in FY 27 to municipalities to the extent the municipality conducts or maintains a municipal youth camp and requires municipal youth camp employees to submit to a background check prior to beginning employment as required by the provisions of the amendment.
