### ***OFA Fiscal Note***

#### ***See Fiscal Note Details***

The amendment strikes sections 23 and 24 and the costs associated with the overdose prevention center pilot.

The amendment (1) changes the date by which the Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS) must establish harm reduction centers to by 7/1/26 instead of 7/1/27 resulting in a shift in program costs, and (2) increases, from three to four, the number of municipalities in which the pilot must be located. This may increase the overall cost of the pilot or adjust the distribution of pilot funds among locations, depending on the scope and design of the program.
