Eliminates Fiscal Impact in Bill

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated impact, resulting in the fiscal impact described below.

The amendment removes minimum standards for marketing practices as a requirement for certification of qualified health plans on the exchange, resulting in no fiscal impact to the state or municipalities.
