## **OFA Fiscal Note**

## Eliminates Fiscal Impact of Bill

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

The amendment results in no fiscal impact. It requires hospitals, including the UConn Health Center, to submit their national provider and taxpayer identification numbers with reimbursement claims for services at certain facilities, and specifies that health carriers are not obligated to provide reimbursement for claims submitted without such information. It is anticipated that UConn Health will be able to meet the bill's provisions with existing resources.
