OFA Fiscal Note

Eliminates Fiscal Impact in Bill

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

The amendment allows for restriction, suspension or revocation of a physician's right to practice if they bill separately for any ancillary service that is routinely bundled with any primary procedure, unless otherwise provided for under state regulation or a relevant health insurance policy. This change results in no fiscal impact to the state or municipalities.
