OFA Fiscal Note

Reduces Cost In Bill

The amendment strikes section 10 of the underlying bill as amended, which makes certain hospital and health care facility violations an unfair trade practice violation. This eliminates the associated potential cost to the Department of Consumer Protection of \$92,500 in FY 26 and \$185,000 in FY 27, along with the potential fringe benefit cost of \$35,078 in FY 26 and \$70,155 in FY 27.
