OFA Fiscal Note

No Fiscal Impact

The amendment strikes Sections 6 and 7 of the bill, which give the commissioner of the Insurance Department the authority to reduce insurance rate premiums for certain fully insured plans and Exchange plans if the increase is above the health care cost growth benchmark. Removing this procedural change results in no fiscal impact to the state.
