OFA Fiscal Note

Eliminates Revenue and Cost Impact in Bill

The amendment, which strikes the underlying bill, eliminates the revenue and cost impacts identified in the fiscal note on the bill.

Instead, the amendment could result in a potential cost to the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection, associated with hiring staff to complete the additional registration, verification and reporting associated with redemption centers and reverse vending machines.
