OFA Fiscal Note

Cost

The amendment requires the State Elections Enforcement Commission (SEEC) to conduct a study on the use of credit card verification codes, and other methods to prevent fraud, and identity theft for campaign finance purposes resulting in a cost. This cost is associated with the need to hire a consultant to carry out the provisions of the study, as SEEC does not currently have the expertise to do so.
