The amendment makes the underlying bill's provisions effective 60 days after the Secretary of the State and the Connecticut State Library (CSL) determine that a similar bill has passed in a state or states with an aggregate population of 7 million. Any change to the bill's potential savings will depend on the timing of policy changed in other states. The potential savings may now first occur in FY 26, FY 27, or in the out years, or, if the condition is not met, never.
