Minimal Revenue Gain

The amendment modifies the underlying bill by extending the time period in which a youth may seek reentry into DCF care and expediting the filing of a motion for associated court review. There is a potential minimal General Fund revenue gain to the extent that additional cases are deemed eligible for federal Title IV-E reimbursement and/or the court determination needed to claim reimbursement of the costs of utilized services is made at an earlier date.

The revised application timeline is consistent with current agency reentry policy. Additionally, DCF can meet the shortened court filing deadline without undue burden.
