No Fiscal Impact

The amendment strikes the underlying bill, resulting in the impact described below.

The amendment establishes a statute of limitations for foreclosure actions and reduces the time after which an unreleased mortgage is invalid under certain circumstances, resulting in no fiscal impact to the state or to municipalities because these changes primarily affect private entities.

The court system disposes of over 20,000 housing summary process cases annually, and the number of cases is not anticipated to be great enough to result in a savings.
