The amendment strikes section 7 of the underlying bill and the associated potential cost to the Department of Social Services (DSS) to create an outreach program for breast cancer survivors.

The amendment allows DSS to require certain Medicaid providers to complete a training in effective pain management as a condition for receiving Medicaid reimbursement for prescribing opioid drugs to Medicaid recipients. This could result in Medicaid savings to DSS to the extent such requirements are established and providers do not complete the training.
