No Fiscal Impact

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and creates a working group to study uniform standards for voting in fire districts and requires the State Elections Enforcement Commission (SEEC) to develop a system to track complaints concerning voting in fire districts resulting in no fiscal impact as the working group has the expertise necessary to complete the provisions of the amendment.
