No Fiscal Impact

The amendment does not change the fiscal impact of the underlying bill. The amendment: (1) allows the bill's health care provider loan reimbursement program to be limited to nonprofit employees, at the Department of Public Health's discretion, and excludes self-employed health care providers from the program; and (2) makes a technical change to the underlying bill.
