AN ACT CONCERNING EMERGENCY NONPROFIT ASSISTANCE. AMENDMENT

The amendment strikes the language in the underlying bill and the associated fiscal impact.

The amendment appropriates \$3 million to several agencies as follows: (1) \$1,450,000 to the Department of Aging and Disability Services for Elderly Nutrition (Meals on Wheels), (2) \$1,450,000 to the Department of Social Services for Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program Supplemental Benefits, and (3) \$100,000 to the Judicial Department for Jewish Family Services of Greenwich.

The amendment results in the budget being under the spending cap by approximately \$164.1 million in FY 25.
