### ***Explanation***

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact resulting in the following impact.

The amendment creates a process for certain occupational licenses to apply to the Department of Consumer Protection to hire additional apprentices resulting in a potential revenue gain to the state to the extent additional occupational licenses are applied for.
