### ***Explanation***

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact resulting in the following impact.

The amendment increases the fee for a homemaker companion agency (HCA) certificate of registration from \$375 to \$450 resulting in an annual revenue gain to the state of approximately \$75,000.<sup>1</sup>

The amendment also makes various changes to P-card procedures and HCA training which result in no fiscal impact to the state.
