### ***No Fiscal Impact***

The amendment allows individuals to file a complaint with the Superior Court rather than the Commission on Human Rights and Opportunities.

This does not result in any fiscal impact to the state or municipalities. The court system disposes of over 250,000 cases annually and the number of cases is not anticipated to be great enough to need additional resources.
