OFA Fiscal Note

Reduces Cost In Bill

The amendment makes several changes including changing the date of required publications against the Department of Corrections (DOC) on the Office of the Correction Ombudsman (OCO), and eliminating Section 2 of the bill, reducing the cost of the underlying bill. This reduction is associated with the elimination of the potential cost to the Office of the Governor (GOV).
