<sup>3</sup> "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2025*) Notwithstanding any <sup>4</sup> provision of title 10 or title 10a of the general statutes, each local and <sup>5</sup> regional board of education and each public institution of higher <sup>6</sup> education shall implement federal Executive Order No. 14201 regarding <sup>7</sup> protecting the safety of females participating in women's sports."
