"AN ACT CONCERNING SCHOOL EMERGENCY RESPONSE SYSTEMS."

1 Strike lines 7 to 34, inclusive, in their entirety and insert the following

2 in lieu thereof:

3 "(a) The Departments of Emergency Services and Public Protection, 4 Administrative Services and Education shall jointly administer a school 5 security infrastructure competitive grant program to reimburse (1) a 6 town, (2) a regional educational service center, (3) the governing 7 authority for a state charter school, (4) the Department of Education on 8 behalf of the technical high school system, (5) an incorporated or 9 endowed high school or academy approved by the State Board of 10 Education pursuant to section 10-34 of the general statutes, (6) the 11 supervisory agent for a nonpublic school, and (7) a licensed child care 12 center or private preschool operator that has received threats, provided 13 no family child care providers may be eligible for reimbursement 14 pursuant to this section, for certain expenses for schools, centers or 15 preschools incurred on or after January 1, 2013, for: (A) The

16 development or improvement of the security infrastructure of schools, 17 centers or preschools, based on the results of school building or child 18 care center building security assessments pursuant to subsection (d) of 19 this section, including, but not limited to, the installation of surveillance 20 cameras, penetration resistant vestibules, ballistic glass, solid core 21 doors, double door access, computer-controlled electronic locks, entry 22 door buzzer systems, scan card systems, panic alarms, hardware 23 associated with emergency response communications systems and 24 personal emergency communication devices, real time interoperable 25 communications and multimedia sharing infrastructure or other 26 systems; and (B) (i) the training of school personnel in the operation and 27 maintenance of the security infrastructure of school buildings, (ii) the 28 hiring and employment of an additional school resource officer, 29 provided such grant funds shall be used for such purpose as follows: (I) 30 Reimbursement for fifty per cent of the salary of such school resource 31 officer for the first year such school resource officer is employed, (II) 32 reimbursement for twenty-five per cent of the salary of such school 33 resource officer for the second year such school resource officer is 34 employed, and (III) reimbursement for fifteen per cent of the salary of 35 such school resource officer for the third year such school resource 36 officer is employed, or [(ii)] (iii) the purchase of portable entrance 37 security devices, including, but not limited to, metal detector wands and 38 screening machines and related training."
