- 3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (h) of section 31-53 of the general statutes is
- 4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1*,
- 5 2025):
- 6 (h) (1) The provisions of this section shall not apply where (A) the
- 7 combined total cost or total bond authorization for all work to be
- 8 performed by all contractors and subcontractors in connection with new
- 9 construction of any public works project is less than one million dollars,
- 10 or (B) the combined total cost of all work to be performed by all
- 11 contractors and subcontractors in connection with any remodeling,
- 12 refinishing, refurbishing, rehabilitation, alteration or repair of any
- public works project is less than one hundred thousand dollars.

(2) On and after October 31, 2017, and prior to July 1, 2019, the provisions of this subdivision shall not apply where the work to be performed by any contractor or subcontractor in connection with new construction, remodeling, refinishing, refurbishing, rehabilitation, alteration or repair of any public works project funded in whole or in part by any private bequest that is greater than nine million dollars but less than twelve million dollars for a municipality in New Haven County with a population of not less than twelve thousand and not more than thirteen thousand, as determined by the most recent population estimate by the Department of Public Health.

- (3) On and after July 1, 2019, and prior to January 1, 2020, the provisions of this subdivision shall not apply where the work to be performed by any contractor or subcontractor in connection with new construction, remodeling, refinishing, refurbishing, rehabilitation, alteration or repair of any public works project funded in whole or in part by any private bequest that is greater than nine million dollars but less than twenty-two million dollars for a municipality in New Haven County with a population of not less than twelve thousand and not more than thirteen thousand, as determined by the most recent population estimate by the Department of Public Health.
- (4) (A) Not later than December 1, 2025, and each December first thereafter, the Labor Commissioner shall determine the adjustment to be made under subparagraph (B) of this subdivision to the total cost thresholds for (i) new construction of any public works project set forth in subparagraph (A) of subdivision (1) of this subsection, and (ii) remodeling, refinishing, rehabilitation, alteration or repair of any public works project set forth in subparagraph (B) of subdivision (1) of this subsection, by the percentage change in the employment cost index, or its successor index, for wages and salaries for all civilian workers, as calculated by the United States Department of Labor, over the twelve-month period ending June thirtieth of the preceding year, rounded to the nearest whole cent.
 - (B) On January 1, 2026, and each January first thereafter, the Labor

Commissioner shall adjust the total cost thresholds for (i) new construction of any public works project set forth in subparagraph (A) of subdivision (1) of this subsection, and (ii) remodeling, refinishing, rehabilitation, alteration or repair of any public works project set forth in subparagraph (B) of subdivision (1) of this subsection, in accordance with the determination made under subparagraph (A) of this subdivision."
