**"AN ACT CONCERNING EXCESSIVE RECKLESS DRIVING."**

1 After line 24, add the following:

2 "(d) No person shall be subject to prosecution because of the same  
3 offense for a violation of both (1) subsection (a) of this section, and (2)  
4 (A) subsection (a) of section 14-219 of the general statutes, or (B)  
5 subsection (a) of section 14-222 of the general statutes."

6 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
7 internal references accordingly:

8 "Sec. 501. Subsection (d) of section 14-219 of the general statutes is  
9 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October*  
10 *1, 2025*):

11 (d) No person shall be subject to prosecution because of the same  
12 offense for a violation of both (1) subsection (a) of this section, and (2)  
13 (A) subsection (a) of section 14-222, [because of the same offense] or (B)  
14 subsection (a) of section 1 of this act.

15       Sec. 502. Section 14-222 of the general statutes is amended by adding  
16       subsection (c) as follows (*Effective October 1, 2025*):

17       (NEW) (c) No person shall be subject to prosecution because of the  
18       same offense for a violation of both (1) subsection (a) of this section, and  
19       (2) (A) subsection (a) of section 14-219, or (B) subsection (a) of section 1  
20       of this act."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Sec. 501	<i>October 1, 2025</i>	14-219(d)
Sec. 502	<i>October 1, 2025</i>	14-222(c)
