## "AN ACT CONCERNING EXCESSIVE RECKLESS DRIVING."

1 After line 24, add the following:

"(d) No person shall be subject to prosecution because of the same
offense for a violation of both (1) subsection (a) of this section, and (2)
(A) subsection (a) of section 14-219 of the general statutes, or (B)
subsection (a) of section 14-222 of the general statutes."

After the last section, add the following and renumber sections andinternal references accordingly:

8 "Sec. 501. Subsection (d) of section 14-219 of the general statutes is
9 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October*10 1, 2025):

(d) No person shall be subject to prosecution <u>because of the same</u>
<u>offense</u> for a violation of both (1) subsection (a) of this section, and (2)
(A) subsection (a) of section 14-222, [because of the same offense] or (B)
<u>subsection (a) of section 1 of this act</u>.
