"AN ACT CONCERNING LGBTQ+ DISCRIMINATION IN LONG-TERM CARE FACILITIES."

1 Strike subsection (f) in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu
2 thereof:

3 "(f) Long-term care facility staff not directly involved in providing
4 direct care to a resident shall not be present during physical examination
5 or the provision of personal care to such resident if such resident is
6 partially or fully unclothed without the express permission of such
7 resident or such resident's legal guardian, legal representative or other
8 legally responsible party. A facility shall use doors, curtains, screens or
9 other effective visual barriers to provide bodily privacy for all residents
10 whenever such residents are partially or fully unclothed. All residents
11 shall be informed of and have the right to refuse to be examined,
12 observed or treated by any facility staff when the primary purpose of
13 such examination, observation or treatment is educational or
14 informational rather than therapeutic, or for the evaluation or

15 reevaluation of a resident's health. Such refusal shall not diminish the
16 resident's access to care for the primary purpose of diagnosis or
17 treatment."
