## "AN ACT CONCERNING GRANTS FOR THE REMOVAL OF PFAS FROM FIRE APPARATUS."

After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
internal references accordingly:

"Sec. 501. (Effective from passage) Not later than October 1, 2025, the 3 4 State Fire Marshal shall establish a one-year pilot program to reimburse 5 firefighters, as defined in section 7-313g of the general statutes, who receive screening for cancers common to firefighters. The State Fire 6 7 Marshal shall consult with a nonprofit organization with expertise in the 8 field of cancer screening to determine which cancer screenings shall 9 qualify for reimbursement pursuant to the pilot program. The pilot 10 program shall be operated in one municipality with a population that is 11 serviced by a volunteer fire department and one municipality with a 12 population that is serviced by a paid fire department. The State Fire 13 Marshal shall accept applications from municipalities, in a form and 14 manner prescribed by the State Fire Marshal, for participation in the 15 pilot program. Not later than January 1, 2027, the State Fire Marshal
