**"AN ACT CONCERNING ONLINE POLITICAL FUNDRAISING
PLATFORMS AND RESTRICTING AUTOMATICALLY RECURRING
CONTRIBUTIONS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) The State Elections Enforcement
4 Commission shall conduct a study on requiring the use of credit card
5 verification value codes, as well as other mechanisms for the prevention
6 of fraud, money laundering and identity theft, when processing
7 transactions for contributions and for other campaign finance purposes.
8 Not later than February 1, 2026, the executive director of the commission
9 shall submit, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the
10 general statutes, a report detailing the results of such study and
11 recommendations for legislation to the joint standing committee of the
12 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to elections. As
13 used in this section, "contribution" has the same meaning as provided in
14 section 9-601a of the general statutes."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Sec. 501	<i>from passage</i>	New section
