"AN ACT CONCERNING ONLINE POLITICAL FUNDRAISING PLATFORMS AND RESTRICTING AUTOMATICALLY RECURRING CONTRIBUTIONS."

After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
 internal references accordingly:

"Sec. 501. Subsection (l) of section 9-140 of the general statutes is
repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

6 (l) No [candidate, party or political committee, or agent of such 7 candidate or committee] <u>person, including any state or municipal</u> 8 <u>official, shall mail [unsolicited applications for absentee ballots to any</u> 9 person, unless such mailing includes: (1) A written explanation of the 10 eligibility requirements for voting by absentee ballot as prescribed in

- 11 12 attempting to vote by absentee ballot without meeting one or more of
- 13 such eligibility requirements subjects the elector or applicant to
- potential civil and criminal penalties. As used in this subsection, "agent" 14
- 15 means any person authorized to act on behalf of another person] or
- 16 deliver any unsolicited application for an absentee ballot to any other
- 17 person unless such other person has requested such application."
