## "AN ACT CONCERNING ROAMING DOGS."

Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
 following in lieu thereof:

"Section 1. Section 22-364 of the general statutes is repealed and the
following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2025*):

5 (a) (1) No owner or keeper of any [dog or] livestock as defined in 6 section 22-381 shall allow such [dog or] livestock to roam at large upon 7 the land of another and not under control of the owner or keeper or the 8 agent of the owner or keeper, nor allow such [dog or] livestock to roam 9 at large on any portion of any public highway and not attended or under 10 control of such owner or keeper or an agent of such owner or keeper. [, 11 provided nothing in this subsection shall be construed to limit or 12 prohibit the use of hunting dogs during the open hunting or training

13 season.] The unauthorized presence of any [dog or] livestock on the land 14 of any person other than the owner or keeper of such [dog or] livestock 15 or on any portion of a public highway when such [dog or] livestock is 16 not attended by or under the control of such owner or keeper, shall be 17 prima facie evidence of a violation of the provisions of this subsection. 18 [Violation of any provision of this subsection shall be an infraction.]

19 (2) No owner or keeper of any dog shall intentionally or as a result of 20 gross negligence allow such dog to roam at large upon the land of 21 another and not under control of the owner or keeper or the agent of the 22 owner or keeper, nor intentionally or as a result of gross negligence 23 allow such dog to roam at large on any portion of any public highway 24 and not attended or under control of such owner or keeper or an agent 25 of such owner or keeper, provided nothing in this subsection shall be 26 construed to limit or prohibit the use of hunting dogs during the open 27 hunting or training season.

(b) The animal control officer or regional animal control officer appointed pursuant to section 22-328, 22-331 or 22-331a, as applicable, of any city or town in which any such dog or livestock is found roaming at large may, in addition to any other remedies provided by law, seek an order enforcing the provisions of this section, including an injunction, from the superior court of the judicial district in which such dog or livestock is found roaming at large.

35 [(b) Any owner or keeper of any dog who, knowing of the vicious 36 propensities of such dog and having violated the provisions of 37 subsection (a) of this section within the preceding year, intentionally or 38 recklessly violates the provisions of subsection (a) of this section shall 39 be fined not more than one thousand dollars or imprisoned not more 40 than six months, or both, if such dog, while roaming at large, causes 41 physical injury to another person and such other person was not teasing, 42 tormenting or abusing such dog.]

43 (c) A violation of subdivision (1) of subsection (a) of this section shall
44 be an infraction.

45	(d) Any owner or keeper of any dog who violates subdivision (2) of		
46	subsection (a) of this section shall be fined not more than three hundred		
47	fifty dollars for a first violation and not more than five hundred dollars		
48	for a second violation. Any subsequent violation of said subdivision by		
49	<u>an owner or keeper of any dog shall be a class C misdemeanor."</u>		
	This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
