"AN ACT CONCERNING ONLINE POLITICAL FUNDRAISING PLATFORMS AND RESTRICTING AUTOMATICALLY RECURRING CONTRIBUTIONS."

After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and internal references accordingly:

"Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Not later than October 1, 2025, the Secretary of the State shall submit a report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to elections (1) identifying each statute, regulation, requirement or part thereof regarding the conduct of elections that was modified or suspended, in whole or in part, by (A) executive order of the Governor issued pursuant to section 28-9 of the general statutes, or (B) declaratory ruling, instruction, opinion or order of the Secretary issued pursuant to section 9-3 of the general statutes for any election or primary held on or after January 1, 2020, and (2) explaining and detailing each such modification or suspension."
